We have chosen to cooperate with Ammeraal Beltech Modular A/S and we believe that a good cooperation gives advantages for all parties.

At Slagteriet Brørup A/S (part of the German meatgroup, Tönnies Fleisch), we are currently running two different tests of special uni ECB cutting belts. The first test was arranged when we needed a total belt width of 1,208 mm. The uni ECB single link design could not be used (maximum belt width is 800 mm). Thus we test belts with bricklay design as they can be made in the requested widths.

The second test is a result of the fact that we need to find a more hard-wearing material. At the moment, we use a belt that is worn out in 3-4 months. Together with Ammeraal Beltech Modular A/S, we are testing various types of material in order to find the very thing.

Our experiences about making our facilities available to Ammeraal Beltech Modular A/S are good. It is perfect for both parties to test new products in 'the real world', before they are introduced on the market. When we allow new things to be tested in our plants, we can have the possibility to have an influence on the result and thus be on top of the development within our field.

In my opinion, the employees at Ammeraal Beltech Modular A/S are generally good at following through on issues – also if changes are needed or something does not work as expected. We have experienced a good and open dialogue between our employees and the product developers with Ammeraal Beltech Modular A/S. The service has been really good – and it has been it all the way through.
